Short Title and	1. These Statutes shall be called by name "Pandit Deendayal
Commencement	Upadhyaya Shekhawati University Statutes, 2017".
Definitions	 In these Statutes, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context: (a) 'The Act' means Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Shekhawati University, Sikar Act, 2012 and 'Section' means a Section of the Act; and (b) 'Officers', 'Authorities', 'Teachers', and 'Ministerial and other Staff' mean, respectively officers, authorities, teachers and ministerial and other staff as expressed in the Act in the of the University. (c) "Words" or "Expressions" used but not defined in these Statutes shall have the same meaning and as assigned to such words or expressions in the Act.

- (vii.) to arrange for the provision of the buildings, premises, furniture and apparatus and other means required for carrying out the work of the University;
- (viii.) to enter into, vary, carry out and cancel contracts/Memorandum of Understanding on behalf of the University;
- (ix.) to entertain and redress any grievances of the officers of the University, teaching staff and the University's servants, who may, for reason whatsever feel aggrieved or otherwise.
- (x.) to publish lists of prescribed or recommended textbooks and to publish syllabus of the prescribed courses of study;
- (xi.) to exercise such other powers and perform other duties as may be conferred or imposed on it by the Act or the Statute.
- (xii.) to decide about the amount of seating charge to be paid the members of Board and other committees, experts, members of selection committees.
- (xiii.) to take note of all administrative orders issued by the Registrar.
- (xiv.) to receives and deliberate upon the minutes of the Academic Council and other committees, appointed by the Board of Management whether standing or otherwise and take further action in furtherance of the minutes.
- (xv.) to decide rate of remuneration to be paid for all type of examination related work including Ph.D. thesis evaluation and conducting viva etc. on the recommendation of Academic Council.
- (xvi.) to receive donation from individuals or corporate for development of the University.
- (xvii.) to frame Regulations to deal with the matters concerning insolent behavior or disorderly conduct.
- (xviii.) to frame rules for Academic Council.
- (xix.) The Board of Management may establish Research Fellowships and Scholarships of such value as it may from time to time, determine tenable for a terms upto three years, for the encouragement for research or original work in such subjects and under such conditions as the Academic Council may prescribe by the Regulation.

 - (c.) honorary Professors, if any, attached to the Department;
 - (d.) such other persons as may be members of the Department in accordance with the provisions of the Statutes;
- (iii.)Each Department shall have a Head, who shall be appointed in the following order of preference:
 - (a.) Professor in the subject by rotation by seniority. When a Professor who is Head of the Department goes on leave without pay/EOL, deputation or he goes on any type of leave for a period of not less than 1 month, the next senior most Professor shall be appointed Head of the Department for said period. This period shall not count towards the term.
 - (b.) When there is no Professor or all Professors are on leave, Associate Professors by rotation by seniority.

When an Associate Professor who is Head of Department goes on leave without pay/extra ordinary leave, deputation or he goes on any type of leave for a period of not less than 1 month, the next senior most Associate Professor shall be appointed Head of the Department for said period. This period shall not count towards the term.

(c.) When there is no Professor or Associate Professor or all Professors and Associate Professors are on leave, Assistant Professors by rotation seniority.

When an Assistant Professor who is Head of the Department goes on leave without pay/extra ordinary leave, deputation or he goes on any type of leave for a



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period of not less than 1 month, the next senior most Assistant Professor shall be appointed Head of the Department for said period. This period shall not count towards the term.

The term of appointment for the Head shall be 3 years. A person appointed as Head of a Department can decline or resign his position as Head at any time during his tenure.

his tenure.

(9) When the Vice-Chancellor is of the opinion that the work/conduct or the activities of the Head of the Department is not in the interest of the Department, he shall submit the case before the Board of Management with all concerned particulars in detail for the consideration. It shall be open for the Board of

Management to remove the Head of the Department and appoint the next senior most person in the order of preference indicated above as Head of the Department.

Proviso: Provided that before taking such an action the Board of Management shall consider the explanation, if any, submitted by the Head of the Department concerned and that no such action shall be taken without the concurrence of 2/3rd of the members of the Board of Management present and voted.

- (10) When a person is removed from the Headship under any of the ground mentioned above, he shall have the right to get reviewed the position from the Board of Management any time after one year of such removal.
- (11) The duties, functions and powers of a Head otherwise than those already prescribed by Act/Statute shall be prescribed by Ordinances.
- (12)(i) Each Department shall have a Departmental Council. The Departmental Council shall be an Authority of the University in terms of Clause (vi) of Sub-Section (b) of Section 10 of Pandit Deendayal Shekhawati University Act, 2012.
 - (ii.) The Departmental Council shall comprise all teachers of the Department.
- (iii.) The Departmental Council shall meet at least thrice in a year and 33% of the total members of the Departmental Council shall constitute the quorum.
 - (iv.) The Head of the Department shall preside over the meetings of the Departmental Council and in his absence the senior most member of the Department shall preside over the said meetings.
 - (v.) Functions of the Departmental Council:
 - (a.) The Departmental Council, without prejudice to the powers conferred on other authorities shall organize teaching and research work in the Department.
 - (b.) The Departmental Council shall recommend to the Board of Studies concerned the Courses and Studies and curriculum for its consideration.
 - (c.) The Departmental Council shall approve and recommend to the 'Examination Committee' a panel of at least twenty paper setters/examiners in each subject/course for appointment as paper setters/ examiners in the University. Ordinarily, no person will be appointed as an examiner in the University

- (e.) The Departmental Council shall frame guidelines for distribution and utilization of grants received from the U.G.C. and the State, other than the Research projects sanctioned to the individual members of the Department.
- (f.) The Departmental Council shall frame guidelines for purchase of books and journals in the subject for the Department/Library.
- (g.) The Departmental Council shall submit a list of the names of experts for consideration of the Academic Council to prepare a panel of experts as provided in the FIRST SCHEDULE to clauses (v) of sub-section (1) of section (5) of the Rajasthan Universities Teachers and Officers Act, 1974, as amended from time to time.
- (h.) The Departmental Council shall submit such proposals as it may deem fit for development of teaching, opening of special papers, starting/strengthening the Research Laboratories and for creation of new teaching posts in the Department to the Academic Council and the U.G.C. and the State.
- (i.) The Departmental Council shall frame definite guidelines for posting of teachers of the Department for teaching in the various other units in the University.
- (j.) The Departmental Council shall give its opinion/ frame guidelines on all other academic and administrative matters not already covered above and other matters referred to it by the Vice-Chancellor/the Dean of the Faculty concerned.
- (vi.) The Departmental Council shall appoint Committees and its In-charges to help the Head of the Department in implementing the decisions on all policy matters as provided above.

(vii.) The decision of the Council will be taken by the majority. In case of tie the presiding officer shall have the casting vote.
 (viii.) Where the Head of the Department finds difficulty in implementing the decisions of the Department.

Where the Head of the Department finds difficulty in implementing the decisions of the Departmental Council or the department Council has taken decision on the otherwise considerations, he shall refer the matter to the Vice-Chancellor with reasons, and the decision of the Vice-Chancellor shall be final.

(13) (i) The University shall confer different Degrees under the different faculties.

(ii.) The University shall not offer any academic programme under any degree unless the said degree has been approved under section 22 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956).

(iii.) No institution/college attached or affiliated to this University will commence any academic programme unless the said degree is notified by the UGC and the same has been incorporated in the list of degrees mentioned in subclause (4) of this Clause and permitted by the University subject to the relevant Statutes and Ordinances of this University.

(v.) Degrees should be specified in generic terms and their nomenclatures should be such that are generally recognized, globally acknowledged, widely accepted and are indicative of level of degrees and the broad subject/ discipline/knowledge.

(vi.) The uniqueness/specialization should be mentioned in the parentheses against the specified generic degrees.

(vii.) The integrated and dual degree programmes should be introduced judicially and with caution. A dual degree programme combines more than one subject, mostly in a horizontal spread, whereas an integrated programme is progressive and cumulative.

(viii.) The academic philosophy/rationale behind offering such integrated programmes should not be for economizing on



course requirements or award of double degrees in a fast track; on the contrary, an integrated approach should involve a vertical/inter-disciplinary discourse. A dual degree should aim for a better comprehension of the related subjects of study from a multi-dimensional perspective. This would necessary entail an equal, if not more, course duration and a newer approach of circular transaction and additional interactive courses. Thus an Integrated/Dual Degree programme combining two or more disciplines shall be permissible only if there is no compromise on any of the course requirements, viz. duration, number of papers and intensity of courses, teaching/learning hours, credits etc. Integrated and Dual Degree programmes are therefore, be introduced by the Universities/institutions subject to the following conditions: (a) The Integrated/Dual Degree Programmes must not dilute the standards as prescribed under the Regulations made by the UGC and other statutory authorities concerned in terms of syllabi, programme duration and examination requirements. (b) If the Integrated/Dual Degree Programmes intend to offer two separate degrees with an option for an interim exit or lateral entry, the duration of the Integrated/Dual Degree must not be less than the duration equal to the sum total of the prescribed duration of the two degrees that are being combined in the Integrated/Dual Degree Programme. Provided that all such programmes would carry the nomenclature of "Integrated/Dual Degree (name of the first degree)- (name of the final degree)".

(ix.) The Post-Graduate Programmes of Study shall ordinarily be conducted in the University Department/ Centre. However, the University may permit any college affiliated to it to run post-graduate programmes even in the affiliated college after the approval of the Board of Studies or (the Department Council in case of the University department), Faculty, and Academic Council.

Provided the Government Colleges/ Government Aided Colleges will be given priority over the private colleges in giving permission (affiliation) to run post-graduate and integrated programmes.

Equivalence Committee: Composition

- (14)(i) There shall be an 'Equivalence Committee' in the University.
 - (ii) The Equivalence Committee will consist of the following:
 - (a.) Deans of all the Faculties.
 - (b.) One Head of Department from each Faculty to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor,
 - (c.) The Committee shall elect its own Chairperson.

- (v.) Not less than half of the number of members shall constitute the quorum for a meeting.
- (vi.) No candidate, who has passed the qualifying examination from any State University situated outside the State of Rajasthan and other than the State Universities (private/deemed) shall not be admitted in any academic programme run by this University unless he has obtained and submitted a 'Provisional/ Final Eligibility Certificate' issued by the officer of the university authorized for the purpose on behalf of the Equivalence Committee of this University.

Explanation: Provisional/Final Eligibility Certificate shall be the condition precedent for the University Department, Constituent College, Institute, Centre and Colleges affiliated to the University for accepting application form for the admission.


(iii.) The term of members other than ex-officio members shall be three years.

The Board of Studies shall recommend to the Faculty concerned the courses of studies and curriculum in their respective subjects.

No book written or published by any person who is the member of the Board of Studies shall be prescribed or recommended for any examination of the University in the respective subject or group of subjects falling in the concerned Board of Studies.

A meeting of the Board of Studies shall be convened by the Chairperson of the Board or in his absence by the Registrar of the University. However, the Chairperson shall convene the meeting of the Board on the requisition in writing by at least three members of the Board.

(vii.) The quorum of the meeting shall be the presence of less than one third members of the Board or the presence of



two members whichever is greater.

(viii.) All questions decided by majority of the votes of the member present and voted. In case of equality of votes, the Chairperson shall have a casting vote.

(ix.) Any item of business before a vote may at the discretion of the Chairperson be disposed up by the correspondence when no member of the Board has objected to the same in written

(x.) When occurs any change or changes in a Subject/Course, it will come into the force not earlier than the next Academic year.

(xi.) The Board of Studies and the Departmental Council shall prepare broader list of teachers working in the University Departments, constituent colleges, affiliated colleges, recognized institutions and external teachers for preparation of Panel for paper-setters/examiners with their qualifications required to be appointed as Paper-Setter and/or examiners for different papers/courses falling within the authority of the respective Board/Departmental Council. However, such list may also be prepared by the University and it may be put before the Departmental Council for preparation of a panel of paper-setters/examiners. However, the Panel for paper-setters must include at least twenty names and the panel of examiners must be double than to be required number of examiners for the concerned paper/course.

prepared by the Board of Studies of the respective

15. CONTROLLER OF EXAMINATION

- (1) There shall be a Controller of Examinations of the University. The Controller of Examinations shall be the whole time salaried officer of the University appointed against a substantive post and shall work as per the directions of the Vice-Chancellor.
- (2) When the post of the Controller of Examinations falls vacant for the reasons whatsoever, the Vice Chancellor shall give the charge of the office of the Controller of Examinations to an employee of the University who is either teacher or an officer of the University.
- (3) The Controller shall be the Member-Secretary of the 'Examination Committee' and of the sub-committees appointed by the Examination Committee except the committees constituted for appointment of paper-setters, examiners and moderators.
- (4) He shall be responsible for prompt and proper implementation of the decisions of the said committees.
- (5) The Controller Of Examination shall exercise the following powers and duties:
 - to conduct examinations, declaration of results and issue documents, such as, certificates, mark-sheets, migration certificates etc; as required by the students.
 - (ii) The Controller shall be responsible for making all arrangements necessary for smooth conduct of the examinations, tests, declaration of the results etc. He shall be responsible: -
 - (a) to prepare and announce in advance the calendar of examinations;
 - (b) to arrange for the timely publication of results of examinations and other tests;
 - (c) to postpone or cancel examinations, in part or in whole, in the event of malpractices or if the circumstances so warrant, and take disciplinary action or initiate any civil or criminal proceedings against any person or a group of persons or an institution (if any) alleged to have committed malpractices. However, he shall discharge this obligation in consultation with



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University Authorities.

(d) To initiate and recommend disciplinary action where necessary against the candidates, paper-setters, examiners, moderators or any other persons connected with examinations and found guilty of malpractices and unfair-means in relation to the examinations on the recommendation of the Grievance Committee;

(e) to review from time to time, the results of university examinations and forward reports thereof to the Academic Council;

Chapter-13 Selection Committee (Section 20 (h))

- 17. (1) Subject to the provisions of the Act, Statute and Ordinances, there shall be a Selection Committee or Committees for appointment on different posts as per the provisions of the ordinances.
 - (2) Members of the teaching staff in the University shall consist servants of the University paid by the University and appointed by the Board of Management as Professors, Associate Professors or Assistant Professors or otherwise as teachers of the University; or person appointed by the Board of Management as honorary Professors, Associate Professors or Assistant Professors or otherwise as teachers of the University.
 - (3) The qualifications of the teachers of the University shall be such as may be determined by the Ordinances.
 - (4) For the selection of all those categories of staff not covered by schedule to the Rajasthan Universities Teachers and Officers (special conditions of services) Act 18 of 1974 as amended by Act 24 of 1976, the composition of selection committees shall be prescribed by the Ordinances and no such staff shall be appointed except on the recommendation of the selection committee so constituted.
 - (5) The meeting of the Selection Committee shall be convened by the Vice-Chancellor.
 - (6) The Selection Committee for those categories of staff not covered by Rajasthan Universities Teachers and Officers (Special Conditions of Services) Act 1974 shall consider and present to the Board of Management recommendations as to the appointment referred to it. When the Board of Management is unable to accept the recommendations made by the Committee, it shall record its reasons and submit the case to the Chancellor for final orders.

Proviso: Provided that no reference to Chancellor shall be required when a Selection Committee's recommendations pertain to any post carrying a pay scale of 5200-20200 (or its revised equivalent from time to time) or below.

(7) Recommendations of Selection Committee for appointments in the University shall remain valid for a period of 6 months from the date, the panel of names recommended by the Selection Committee is approved by the Board of Management and no appointment shall be deemed to have satisfied the requirements

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- of law and to have been validly made unless made within 6 months of the date on which the Board of Management approved the recommendations of the Selection Committee.
- (8) No appointment from the panel of names recommended by a Selection Committee and approved by the Board of Management shall be made in senior grades (like Associate Professor and Professor in Teaching cadres, Deputy Registrar and Registrar in administration, Deputy Librarian and Librarian in Library, University Engineer) against leave vacancies.

(9) No ad-hoc appointment shall be made to fill in vacancies in senior cadres/grades (like Associate Professor, Professor in teaching cadre.)

(10) A person holding a temporary appointment after due and regular selection shall be eligible for permanent absorption without facing a selection committee again when a permanent vacancy arises provided that the permanent vacancy does not call for any specialization and for this purpose the period served by him in temporary capacity shall count towards probation upto a maximum of one year.

Proviso: Provided that the person was selected for initial appointment as above in response to an advertisement inviting applications for permanent vacancies but was appointed temporarily for want of a permanent vacancy.

(11) When a post is advertised as a temporary/leave/lien vacancy post, persons whose names are recommended by the Selection Committee holding selections in response thereto shall be appointed temporarily. They shall not be eligible for permanent absorption, when such a vacancy arises later.

Chapter-15 Affiliation of Colleges/Institutions and Their Management

	19. (1) Colleges or Institutions, within the territorial limits of the Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Shekhawati University may be admitted to such privileges of the University as the Board of Management may decide on the following conditions:			
	 (i) Every affiliated college shall be a public educational institution; (ii) The whole of the funds of an affiliated college shall be applied to its own educational purpose; (iii) Every such College or Institution shall have regularly. 			
	constituted Governing Body/Council, approved by the Board of Management. At least three representatives of the teaching staff, of whom the Principal of the College or the Head of the Institution shall be one and the remaining two shall be selected from amongst its teachers, and two representatives of the University nominated by the Vice chancellor shall be included in the Governing Body or			
	Proviso: Provided further that the term of the office of the University nominee shall be for the period of three academic years and a person once nominated shall be eligible for re-nomination. (iv) Any change in the constitution of the governing body shall be reported forthwith to the Board of Management. (v) The Principal of College shall be responsible for the internal administration of the College. (vi) Every College or institution shall satisfy the Board of			
	Management on the following points: (a) the suitability and adequacy of its accommodation and equipment for teaching; (b) the qualifications and adequacy of its teaching staff, their emoluments and the conditions of their service as prescribed by the University Grants Commission, university and the regulatory authority if any; (c) every college shall maintain a proportion of teachers to students which is not smaller than the resident.			

to students which is not smaller than the minimum

- to be prescribed by University Grants Commission, regulatory authority and the University Ordinance and which is sufficient for tutorial supervision too.
- (d) the arrangements for the residence, welfare, discipline and supervision of its students(s);
- (e) that adequate financial provision has been made for the continued maintenance of the college; and
- (f) such other matters as are essential for the maintenance of the standards of University education.
- (vi) Every college shall provide instruction only in such subject which are provided under the Statute and Ordinance of the University and has a provision for such examinations as may be authorized in respect of that college, from time to time by the Board of Management.
- (viii) Every college shall satisfy the University that it is in all respects suitably organized and conducted.
- (ix) Every college not maintained by a Government shall maintain a provident fund/Contribution under the New Pension Scheme, 2004 for the benefit of members of its teaching staff, with rules approved by the University.
- (x) A teacher dismissed for misconduct by an affiliated College shall not be employed by any other affiliated college without the previous consent in writing of the Vice-Chancellor.
- (xi) No college or institution shall be admitted to any privilege of the University except on the recommendation of the Board of Management made after considering the report of a committee of Inspection appointed for the purpose by the University.
- (xii) Colleges and Institutions desirous of admission to any privilege of the University shall be required to intimate their intension to do so in writing so as to reach the Registrar not later than the 30th April of the preceding year from which permission applied for is to have effect.
 - Proviso: Provided that the University may declare any academic year as zero year for the purpose of new privilege/affiliation for any academic programme or programmes. In such situation the application for privilege/affiliation shall not be entertain.
- (xiii) A college or institution may not, without the previous permission of the Board of Management and Academic Council suspend instruction in any subject or course of study for which it is authorized to teach.
 - Note: Subject to the provisions of this chapter, the University shall have authority to conduct periodic/sudden inspection of the college/institution.
- (2) Subject to the provisions of Act, Statutes and Ordinance, appointment to the teaching staff of such colleges or institutions shall be made on the recommendations of a Selection Committee, which shall include the Principal, at least one of the representatives of the University on the Governing body and one expert nominated by the Academic Council.
- (3) No teacher including the Principal will be appointed in an affiliated college/institution unless the recommendation to appoint him has been approved by the university and subject to the provisions of Statute; the teacher has been recognized by the university for the said purpose.

Proviso: Provided that the provisions of the clause (2) and (3) shall not apply in the case of colleges and institutions





maintained by the Government.

- (4) This will be mandatory for every college or institution to be inspected at least once every year by a committee appointed by the University. The Board of Management after considering report submitted by the Board of Inspection with its recommendations shall forward a copy of the report to the Governing Body of the College or Institution with such remarks, if any, as it may deem fit, for suitable action.
- (5) The Board of Management may, after consulting the Academic Council, withdraw any privileges granted to a college or Institution at any time it considers that the college or institution is not fulfilling the requisite conditions;

Proviso: Provided that before any privileges are so withdrawn the Governing Body/Government shall be given an opportunity to represent to the Board of Management why such action should not be taken.

(6) Subject to the conditions set forth above, the Ordinances may prescribe any other conditions which may be considered necessary and also provide the procedure for the admission of colleges/ institutions to the privileges of the University and for the withdrawal of those privileges.

(7) Every college/institution shall maintain such registers, records and documents as prescribed by the norms set under the Ordinances of the university, government and regulatory authority and furnish to the university as desired at the time of the inspection first and periodic.

(8) It will be mandatory for every college/institution to submit on or before the date fixed by the Board of Management a detailed report of the previous academic year giving particulars and the circumstances of any change in the management of the college/ Institution, teaching staff, number of students, statement of income and expenditure and such other information as required by the university.

(9) Every college shall satisfy the university that it is in all respect suitably organized and conducted.

(10) Every college shall confirm to the University the period of academic terms/ semester and vacations.

(11) In every college the fee charged shall be such as approved by the University.

(12) No college/institution will charge any fee not approved by the University including the additional fee in name of any service, development etc.

(13) Every college shall satisfy the University that it has adequate library, adequate system of cataloging of books, building, furniture, laboratory, laboratory equipments, other equipments and land as per the norms set by the appropriate authorities and the University.

(14) Every College shall satisfy the University that proper discipline is maintained at its college, hostels and campus.

(15) Every college shall adequate provisions for residence of its students not residing with their parents or recognized guardian. They shall be provided with adequate facilities for physical exercise, health and medical examination, care residence in college or hostels as per the norms approved by the University.


(16) Every college and its hostel shall be subject to the inspection by the University, Board of Management or a person appointed by them on their behalf.

(17) Every College must have a separate retiring room when studies female students with necessary facilities for them.

(18) Procedure for Affiliation of College of College/Institution:

Every college/ institution shall be admitted to the privilege of the university by way of affiliation to the





university:

(i.) Colleges and Institutions desirous of admission to any privileges of the University shall be required to intimate their intention to do so in writing so as to reach the Registrar not later than the 30th April of the preceding year from which permission applied for is to have effect.

(ii.) Under the "University College/ Institution affiliation System", the University will be considered as the "Affiliation Provider", and College/ Institution shall be considered as the "Affiliation Receiver" Institution.

(iii.) The authority to grant affiliation will be the sole privilege vested with the University subject to the norms, standards, policy and procedure established by the law irrespective of the fact that whether the college/institution has been granted recognition by the regulatory authority.

(iv.) The University is under an obligation to carry out the inspection for the purpose of affiliation at the time of new affiliation and when expires the earlier affiliation in case of temporary/provisional/periodic affiliation.

(v.) The affiliation of the college/ institution will be ceased automatically once the earlier period of the affiliation has expired.

(vi.) In case of a professional academic programme, the recognition/permission of the regulatory authority will be a condition precedent for university affiliation.

Provided that no collection is a condition of the regulatory authority will be a condition precedent for university affiliation.

Proviso: Provided that no college/institution shall admit any student or the Coordinator of the Central Admission Committee will admit/allot any student to any College/institution unless and until the college/institution has been grant affiliation by the University.

(vii.) No college/institution shall be admitted to any privileges of the University except on the recommendation of the Board of Management made after considering the report of a Committee of the Inspection appointed for the purpose by the Board of Management.

(viii.) The University in no case will grant conditional affiliation.

(19) A college applying for affiliation for the first time or for the extension in case of temporary/ provisional affiliation or for additional subject or for additional course or for permanent affiliation within the prescribed period by written application to the Registrar of the University accompanied with the required documents and fee notified by the University in the academic year preceding to the proposed academic year for which affiliation application is required to be submitted. However, the University may extend the date to accept such application as special case after the expiry of the last date with the late fee as determined by the University.

(20) When a college/institution applies for any integrated academic programme then such college/institution will be required to pay application fees, inspection fees and affiliation fees required to be paid for each academic programme.

(21) In case of an integrated course, the college/institution must have adequate qualified teachers for all the subjects involved there in proportion of the workload and teachers required for the purpose.

(22) An application may be withdrawn by the concerned college/ Institution at any time before the college/institution is





inspected.

(23) The inspection has to be conducted in the year preceding to the academic year for which the privilege has been sought. However, it will be the obligation of the college concerned to ensure that the inspection for the purpose has to be carried out in the said preceding academic year. Failure in this regard will result into the no claim for refund of any fee/deposit on the ground that the inspection has not been conducted by the

(24) The University in no case can grant affiliation with

(25) The Board of Management shall provide for the periodical inspection of each college/institution and may cause inspection

to be made at any time.

(26) The Board of Management and the university on behalf of the Board shall have power to cause enquiry to be made with respect to any matter connected with a college/ Institution. In such case notice will be served to the management of the college/ Institution of the intention to cause enquiry and the management will be entitled to submit its representation.

(27) The Board of Management may as a result of the such inspection and enquiry advise the college / Institution concerned on any matter, or direct the management of the concerned college/ Institution to take such action as specified within the period specified. The College/Institution shall be

under an obligation to take such actions.

(28) The Board of Management shall have power to withdraw the privilege/affiliation granted at any time after the due enquiry if the College/Institution does not conduct it obligations in accordance with the conditions laid down by the university at the time recognition/affiliation granted or thereafter and norms prescribed under the Statutes, Ordinances and the guidelines issued by the University Grants Commission and the concerned regulatory authority. However, in this process the management of the concerned College/ Institution will be provided an opportunity to appear before the enquiry and submit its representation by recording its opinion on the said representation.

(29) The Board of Management shall have privilege/affiliation to withdraw the recognition in respect of any subject or course of

study after inspection.

(30) Application for affiliation of college/ Institution offering courses in different Faculties leading to degree in graduation or post graduation shall be considered only when the College/ Institution concerned has sought No-objection certificate/ recognition from the National regulatory Authority concerned when the law provides so.

Proviso: Provided that neither the said ' no objection certificate' issued by the university nor the recognition 'given by the regulatory authority will debar/limit the authority of the university to conduct the inspection of the said college/ Institution. Further, it will not be obligatory for the university to compulsorily consider the case for affiliation even after the

said no-objection certificate/recognition.

(31)(A) There shall be a Board of Inspection for giving affiliation to the college/institution. The Board shall consists of following members:

(i.) the Vice-Chancellor;

(ji.) the Director of College Education, Rajasthan;

(lii.)Dean(s) of all the Faculties;

(B) (i) The Board shall deal with the applications for affiliation, recognition or approval of colleges/institutions within the jurisdiction of the University, arrange for their inspection in the

manner prescribed by the Statutes and make recommendations to the Board of Management in this regard to their affiliation, recognition or approval as the case may be;

(ii) The Board shall appoint to committees consist of not exceeding five members each, one to deal with the application forms for the colleges and another to deal with approval of the institutions. The committees shall be appointed for a period of

Subject to the approval of the Board of Management (iii) the Board of Inspection may make rules for affiliation of colleges and institutions.

(C) The Board of Inspection may prepare every year a panel of Inspectors to inspect the colleges/institutions. The Inspectors will be appointed by the University for different colleges:

(i) for Degree/Graduate colleges (other than Post-Graduate colleges):

(a.) University Professors and Associate Professors;

(b.) Principals of Degree and Post-Graduate colleges; (c.) Head of the Post-Graduate Departments;

(d.) Teachers possessing at least fifteen years experience of teaching degree and/or post-graduate classes out of each at least five years should be the experience of teaching at post-graduate level:

(ii) for Post-Graduate colleges:

(a.) Professors of the University and/or of any recognized Indian University;

(b.) Principals of Post-Graduate colleges affiliated to University or of any recognized Indian University; and

(c.) University Associate Professor;

N.B.: In exceptional circumstances a retired person who has held the above position may also be appointed.

(D) The number of Inspectors appointed by the Board of Studies shall be the subject of following limits:

(i) for Degree/Graduate colleges (other than Post-Graduate colleges):

(a.) For new affiliation: one person from each Faculty but not less than two in any case;

(b.) For affiliation in additional subject: one person from each faculty;

(ii) for Post-Graduate colleges:

(a.) For affiliation in Post graduate subject: one person in each subject:

(iii) For Periodical inspection: two person from degree colleges and colleges pursuing post graduate study in one faculty only, three persons from colleges pursuing post-graduate study in more than one faculty and two persons for approved institutions.

(E) Qualification of teachers in affiliated colleges and institutions shall be determined by university Ordinance accepted and based on the Guidelines prepared and issued by the University Grants Commission and the concerned national regulatory authorities and adopted by the University.

(32) Syllabus and Scheme of Examinations in the affiliated colleges/institutions: The Syllabus and the Scheme of Examination for academic programmes proposed to be run in the affiliated colleges or institutions shall be same as applicable for regular students of the University in the concerned subject and adopted by the University.

Chapter-17

University Accounts and Audit (Section 34)

- 21. (1) The Comptroller of the University under the direction of the Vice-Chancellor shall prepare annual accounts and balance sheet of the University. All money occurs to or received by the University from whatever sources and all kinds of amount disbursed or paid shall be entered in the accounts.
 - (2) The Comptroller shall prepare the financial estimates/revised financial estimates for the current and the forthcoming year on or before the date prescribed.
 - (3) The annual accounts and the annual financial estimates prepared by the Comptroller shall be placed before the Board of Management with the remarks of the Finance Committee for approval. The Board may pass resolution with reference thereto and communicate the same to the Comptroller who shall take action in accordance with it.

Proviso: Provided that when for the reasons whatsoever, the Board cannot pass the proposed annual budget, the vice-chancellor shall have an authority to develop notional contingency fund for a period of three months on the recommendation of the comptroller to carry out the financial functioning of the university.

(4) The annual accounts when audited shall be printed and copies thereof shall be submitted by the Vice-Chancellor to the Board with the audit report. The Board shall forward it to the State Government with such comments as may be deemed to be necessary.

- (iv) 'Government' means the Government of Rajasthan;
- (v) 'Head of Department' means an authority specified in the General Financial and Accounts Rules of the Rajasthan Government and includes such other authority or person whom the Government may, by order specify as Head of a Department.
- (vi) 'Head of Office' means a Gazetted Officer who is declared as such under Rule 3 of the General Financial & Accounts Rules, and includes such other authority or person whom the competent authority may, by order, specify as Head of Office;
- (vii) "Intermediary" includes pension fund, central recordkeeping agency, pension fund advisor, retirement advisor, point of presence and such other person or entity, connected with collection, management, record keeping and distribution of accumulations;
- (viii) New Contributory Pension Scheme means the defined contribution pension scheme as operationalized by Government of Rajasthan, vide Memorandum NreF I 3(1)FD/RulesI2003, dated 28.1.2004 and Memorandum No. F13(1)FD/Rules/2003, dated 27.32004 as amended from time to time
- (ix) "New recruits" means university servants/employees appointed for the services of university on or after the 01.01.2004 (12.10.2012 in case of this university).
- (x) "Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority" means the pension fund regulatory and development authority established under sub-section(I) of section 3, of the Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority Ordinance, 2004 of Government of India or a similar authority established by Government of Rajasthan.
- (xi) "Point of Presence" means an entity registered with the Authority under subsection (3) of section 24 of the Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority Ordinance, 2004 of Government of India or a similar entity appointed by Government of Rajasthan, as a point of presence and capable of electronic connectivity with the central recordkeeping agency for the purposes of receiving and transmitting funds and instructions and pay out of funds;
- (xii) "State" or "State Government" means Government of Rajasthan.

- (6) The accounts under the following head with under mentioned details will be opened to deposit the contribution of the employees appointed on and after January 1st, 2004 (October 12th, 2012 in case of this University) under the New Contributory Pension Scheme:
 - 8011-Insurance and Pension Fund
 - 106- Other Insurance and Pension Fund
 - (03) New Contributory Pension Scheme
 - [03] Account for Committees, Commissions, Government



Undertakings and other Institutions.

Note: 1. The above mentioned heads will be operated by the Director, Insurance and General Provident Fund.

- 2. Subject to the provisions of New Contributory Pension Scheme the contribution fund of/for the employees appointed after 01.01.2004 (12.10.2012 in the case of this University) will be deposited under the New Contributory Pension Scheme in these heads.
- 3. The university will regularly forward the full detail/particulars of all the employees to Director, Insurance and General Provident Fund.
- 4. The director, Contributory Fund will allot a unique identification number of the employees and maintain their accounts.

(7) Compulsory subscription to Pension Fund:

- (i.) It would be mandatory for new recruits to become member of the new contributory pension scheme and the monthly contributions to their pension account shall be @10 percent of the Basic Pay, Dearness Pay and D.A. paid from the salary of the employee and a matching amount shall be contributed by the State Government. This matching contribution from the State Government shall be charged to the respective salary head of account.
- (ii.) The contributions would be deposited in a non-withdrawable pension account. As an interim measure, the amount of contributions towards the pension account shall be retained in an interest bearing Public Deposit Account interest on the balance of Personnel Deposit Account shall be paid on the rates applicable to interest bearing PD Account. Final arrangements will be made as per provisions of rule 12(1) or rule 12(2).

(8) Exit from the Scheme:

A university servant can exit from the scheme on attaining the age of superannuation i.e. on the age of 60 years or as notified time to time by the appropriate authority. At exit it would be mandatory, for him to invest 40 percent of pension wealth to purchase an annuity (from an IRDA regulated Life Insurance Company), which will provide for pension for the lifetime of the employee and his dependent parents/spouse.

(9) Particulars of the employee and nomination:

Immediately on joining university service, the university servant will be required to provide particulars such as his name, designation, scale of pay, date of birth, nominees (a) for the fund, relationship of the nominee etc. in the prescribed form (Annexure 1). The Head of Office concerned will be responsible for obtaining this information from all university servants covered under the new pension scheme. Consolidated information for all those who have joined service during the month shall be submitted by the Head of Office concerned in the prescribed format (Annexure II) to the unit office of State Insurance and Provident Fund Department by 7th day of the following month.

(10.) Allotment of Account Number:

On receipt of Annexure II from the Heads of Office, the Unit Office of State Insurance and Provident Fund will allot a unique 12 digit Permanent Pension Account Number-PPAN- to each employee appointed in the University on or after 12-10-2012. The first four digits



of this number will indicate the calendar year of joining university service by the employees, *the* next digit "I" indicates that it is a Civil Pensioner, the next two digits would represent the Code for Unit Office of State Insurance and Provident Fund Department and the last five digits will be the running serial number of the individual university servant alloted by the Unit Office of State Insurance & Provident Fund. The list of codes allotted for each Unit Office/District Office of State Insurance and Provident Fund Department is appended at Annexure III. The format of PPAN is as under:

(11.) Recovery of the Deposit:

- (i) The Heads of Office shall prepare separate pay bill in respect of the university servants joining university service on or after 01.01.2004 (12.10.2012 in case of this university) and attach a schedule of government servants contribution in prescribed form (Annexure IV). The Heads of Office shall prepare a separate pay bill register in respect of such university servants.
- (ii) Along-with the salary bill for the university servants who join service on or after 01.01.2004 (12.10.2012 in case of this university), the Heads of Office shall also prepare a separate salary bill for drawl of matching contribution to be paid by the government for credit to respective Pension Account.
- (iii) The bill for drawl of matching contribution should also be supported by schedules of recoveries in form (Annexture V).
- (iv) The university will be under an obligation to prepare the bill of the employee's deduction (contribution) bill and the matching contribution of State Government bill simultaneously and submit it together in the Treasury.

 Proviso: Provided that, no official who has obligation to accept the said bills in the Treasury will not accept such bill unless both the bills have been submitted together.

(12.) Maintenance of Account and preparation of data base-

- (i) On receipt of the salary bills in respect of government servants joining service on or after 01.01.2004 (12.10.2012 in case of this university), the Treasury Officer will exercise usual checks and pass the bills for payment. The schedules relating to Pension Contribution will be detached from the bills as done in the case of other schedules such as GPF. The schedules will then be furnished to the Unit Office of State Insurance and Provident Fund for posting the credits of contribution in the detailed ledger account of the individual employee.
- (ii) The Unit Office of State Insurance and Provident Fund on receipt of schedules from the Treasury Officer will update its database and generate exception reports for missing



credits, mismatches etc which will be sent back to the Head of Office concerned for further action.

(iii) The District Office of State Insurance and Provident Fund shall send the compiled information of contribution recovered from the employee's salary towards Pension Fund as well as the matching contribution from government every month by 15th of the next month to the Director, State Insurance and Provident Fund for maintaining record of all the employees appointed on or after 01.01.2004 (12.10.2012 in case of this university).

At the end of each financial year, the Director, State Insurance and Provident Fund shall prepare annual account statements for each employee showing the opening balance, details of monthly deductions and government's matching contributions, interest earned and the closing balance. The Director, State Insurance and Provident Fund shall send these statements to the Heads of Office through its Unit offices for distribution to the respective university servants and obtain receipt from them.

(13.) Recontilation with Public Deposit Account-

After the close of each financial year, the Director, State Insurance and Provident Fund will reconcile the figures of contribution posted in the ledger account of the individual as per their ledger with balance in the P.D. Account.

(14.) Withdrawals-

No withdrawal of any amount will be allowed till attaining the age of superannuation i.e. upto 60 years or the age as decided by the appropriate authority from time to time. However, in the event of untimely death of an employee payment will be made to the lawful nominees. In case an employee leaves service voluntarily, no withdrawal will be allowed till his attaining the age of 60 years.

Provided that in ease of removal/dismissal from the service of an employee, Government's share shall stand withdrawn and shall be deposited in General Revenue head of the State. The employee may withdraw his share.

(15.) Management of the Fund.

- (i.) The Fund raised in the University will be managed by the Pension appointed by the State Government. It will be regulated by the Regulations notified by the State Government for this purpose.
- (ii.) The State Government can exercise the option to join the New Contributory Pension Scheme of the Central Government as notified vide extraordinary Gazette of India No. 42 dated 29-12-2004 and as may be modified from time to time and the said option exercised by the university will be treated as adopted by the university.
- (iii.) Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, in the event of the State Government exercising the option to join the Central Government's Contributory Pension Scheme, the contributions towards pension fund deposited in the interest bearing P.D. account of State Government will be transferred to the intermediaries pegistered and regulated by Pension Fund regulatory and Development Authority Constituted by the Central Government and

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thereafter regular contribution will also be transferred to them. The functions relating to record keeping will be assigned to the Central record keeping agency registered and regulated by the aforesaid Authority. On death or retirement on superannuation or otherwise the retirement benefits will be paid by the intermediaries registered and regulated by the Central Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority as per the rules/ regulations specified by the Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority for this purpose. On this account, there will be no financial liability of the State Government/university.

An employee of the university, who has been recruited and joins the university services or has been absorbed in the university services shall be governed by the new contributory pension scheme irrespective of the fact that he has served on any post permanent or otherwise under the Government of India, Government of Rajasthan, Government of any State or the Union Territory, local, autonomous or any other authority within the territory of India or under the control of the Government of India/Government of Rajasthan.

Explanation:

1. Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Shekhawati University, Sikar and the Government of Rajasthan will not be liable for any purpose for the services rendered by the university employee on or before 01.01.2004 (12.10.2012 in case of this university).

2. When an employee of the State Government has been recruited or absorbed in the services of the university shall be considered as retired employee of the State Government and accordingly he will be entitled for State Service Pension as per the option/service retirement benefits and the capitalize value of the pension as applicable and paid by the State Government. The University will not be liable to pay/confer any such benefit to him. For the purpose of University services he will be considered university employee from the date of his joining and absorption and governed by the New Contributory Pension Scheme.

(17.) Additional Relief on death/disability of University Employees covered by the new Defined Contributory Pension System (NPS)

(i.) The new pension scheme is a replacement for only pension under normal circumstances and family pension in case of death of employees after retirement.

(ii.) There shall be a provision of some additional benefits that can be provided on death or discharge on invalidation/ disability of a university employee covered by the New Pension Scheme subject to the Rules and Regulations enacted time to time by the appropriate government.

(iii.) Employees appointed on or after 01.01.2004 (12.10.2012 in case of this university) who are discharged on invalidation / disablement and by the families of such employees who have died during service since 01.01.2004 (12.10.2012 in case of this university), the Governor is pleased to extend the following benefits to the State Government/University employees covered by the New Pension Scheme on provisional basis till further orders:

A. Retirement from Government service on invalidation not attributable to Government duty.

(a.) Invalid Pension calculated in terms of Rules 35 and Rule 54 of the Rajasthan Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1996.

(b.) Retirement gratuity computed in terms of Rule 55 of the Rajasthan Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1996.

- B. Death in service not attributable to Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Shekhawati University duty.
 - (a.) Family Pension (including enhanced family pension) computed in terms of Rule 60 to 74 of the Rajasthan Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1996.
 - (b.) Death gratuity computed in terms of Rule 55 of the Rajasthan Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1996.
- C. Discharge from Government service due to disease/injury attributable to Government duty:
 - (a.) Disability pension computed in terms of provisions of Chapter VIII -Extra Ordinary Pension of Rajasthan Civil Service (Pension) Rules, 1996.
 - (b.) Retirement gratuity computed in terms of Rule 55 of the Rajasthan Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1996.
- D. Death in service attributable to Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Shekhawati University duty:-
 - (a.) Extraordinary Family Pension under Chapter VIII and Special pensionary awards under Chapter VII of the Rajasthan Civil Services (Pension) Rules 1996.
 - (b.) Death gratuity computed in terms of Rule 55 of the Rajasthan Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1996.
- (iv.) The employees / his family will also be paid Dearness Pension / Dearness Relief admissible from time to time in addition to the above benefits on provisional basis if admissible as per provisions of Rule 77 of RCS (Pension) Rules, 1996.
- (v.) The above payments shall be considered as provisional payments. The said provisional payments will be adjusted against the final payments to be made in accordance with the rules to be issued as per the pattern of Government of India and recoveries, if any, will be made from the future payments to be made on the basis of those rules.
- (vi.) The payment of various benefits on death/discharge of a university employee is envisage after adjustment of the monthly annuities pension from the accumulated funds in the NPS Account of the employee. Therefore, no payment of monthly-annuitised pension will be made to the employee/family of the employee during the period he/she is in receipt of the provisional benefits.
- (vii.) In cases where on discharge/death of the employee, the amount of accumulated funds in the NPS Account have been paid to the employee/family of the employee, the amount of monthly- annuitised pension from the date of discharge/death will be worked out and the same will be adjusted against the payment of benefits/relief payable under this order.
- (viii.) The families of Government servants who expired / expires during the period of probation while drawing fixed remuneration in that case the Contribution towards New Contributory Pension Scheme at the rate of 10% of the fixed remuneration shall be deducted/adjusted from the amount of DCRG by the Director, Pension and Pensioner Welfare Department and the amount so deducted shall be sent to the Director, Insurance and Provident Fund for crediting in PPAN with PRAN (by opening new account) family pension shall be allowed to the family of deceased University Employee.

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- (ix.) These instructions will be applicable to those university employees who joined university service on or after 01.01.2004 (12.10.2012 in case of this university) and will take effect from the same date i.e. 01.01.2004 (12.10.2012 in case of this university).
- (x.) Procedure of sanctioning provisional pension / family pension shall be as under:
- A. The Head of Office will prepare the pension papers in the format of the provisional pension / family pension as per the provision of this memorandum and will submit the same along with all the relevant documents and requisite number of photographs, the particular of the bank account of the pensioner (viz. name of bank, name of branch, full postal address of branch with PIN, 7 digit BSR code, IFSC code etc) to the Director, Pension and Pension Welfare Department, Rajasthan, Jaipur through the Director, State Insurance and General Provided Fund Rajasthan, Jaipur. The Head of Office will be responsible for the correctness of the bank details of the pensioner. The permanent pension account number (PPAN) with the permanent retirement account number (PRAN) of the concerned Government Servant allotted by the Office of State Insurance and Provident Fund Department will also be indicated.
- B. The Head of Office will obtain an undertaking from the pensioner/family pensioner to the effect that he/she has understood the provisions of FD Memorandum dated 09.05.2013 as amended under this memorandum and that any payment found to be in excess of his / her entitlement will be refunded to Government / adjusted out of his/her final entitlement. The Head of Office will forward this undertaking to the Director, Pension and Pensioners' Welfare Department alongwith the pension papers.
- C. After receiving such case the Director, Pension and Pensioners'
 Welfare Department will provide following information to the
 Director, State Insurance and Provident Fund for verification & Director,
 State Insurance and Provident Fund Department shall provide verification
 - (a.) Verification of Employee ID, PPAN and PRAN
 - (b.) The amount of accumulated fund in the NPS Account of the employee as envisage in para 'H' of clause (x) of this Statute
 - (c.) The amount of pension contribution in NPS Account of the employee already paid to be adjusted against the payment of benefit / relief payable as per para 'I' of clause (x) of this Statute.
 - (d.) In the case of death of a university employee during probation period New PPAN with PRAN shall be allotted on receipt of case for grant of family pension as per para 'J' of clause (x) of this Statute.
 - (e.) An affidavit given by the pensioner / family pensioner shall be kept in record by the Director, Pension and Pensioners' Welfare Department.
 - (f.) The amount received from Central Record Keeping Agency (CRA).
- D. Pension and Pensioner Welfare Department after scrutinizing the pension papers will finalize the pensionary entitlement as admissible under this Memorandum / relevant rules / orders and issue authorities for pension/ family pension / gratuity to the Treasury Officer for payment and shall also sent one copy to the Director, State Insurance and PF Department for updating his record. Separate pension payment order number shall be allotted to these provisional pensioners / family pensioners.
- E. Pension and Pensioner Welfare Department shall record the entitlements admitted in the Service Book of the University Employee under his signature.
- F. Director, Pension and Pensioner Welfare Department and Director, State





- Insurance and PF Department will maintain an index register and a separate data base in respect of all pensioners / family pensioners to whom provisional payments are made.
- G. Pensioner may open joint account with spouse only (to whom family pension is payable in the event of death of pensioner)
- H. The pension account holding bank will have to obtain an undertaking from the pensioner / family pensioner that the excess payment, if any, credited to his / her account, can be recovered by the bank.
- The Director, Pension and Pensioner Welfare Department and State Insurance Department shall be responsible for all recoveries. They shall work out the final payments / recoveries as and when orders to this effect are issued by the Government.
- J. In case of death of pensioner / family pensioner, the same may be intimated to the pension account holding branch of the bank by the family members of the deceased immediately and bank will inform the same to the Director, Pension and Pensioner Welfare Department and State Insurance and Provident Fund Department.
- K. Except indicated above the rest part of procedure for authorisation of pension and payment of pension / family pension shall be as contained in Rajasthan Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1996.


