Please read all these instructions very carefully and follow them:

1. Important Dates and timings

The date of RET 2023 examination (a) 24 Dec 2023 (b) Reporting time at examination center 11.30 a.m. (c) Time of Examination 12.15 p.m Entry at given center will not be allowed after (d) 11.30 a.m. Admit card/ Permission letter available from (e) : 20 Dec 2023

- 2. The permission letters for appearing in RET 2023 examination will be made available on university website www.shekhauniexam.in. Candidates will have to take its printout before coming to examination center. Center of examination will be mentioned on the permission letter itself. Centre copy will be retained by the centre and student copy will be kept by student.
- 3. While coming to examination center, candidates will have to carry **ORIGINAL ID PROOF** (Any one of these: PAN card, Aadhar Card, Driving License, Voter ID Card, Passport) with them. Each candidate has to submit the **XEROX COPY OF ID PROOF** at the examination center. **The entry in examination center will not be allowed without valid ID proof**.
- 4. The mobile phone or any wireless device (in any mode), calculators or any such device are not allowed at the examination center.
- 5. Examination will have two papers. No gap will be provided between two papers. The first paper will start at 12.15 a.m. to 01.45 p.m. and 2nd paper will be of start at 01.46 p.m. to 03.15 p.m. Before opening of sealed question booklets, candidates are advised to read given instructions very carefully. All the entries on OMR sheets should be filled in by blue or black ball point pen.
- 6. (a) Paper- I of this exam will contain 50 multiple choice questions and all questions will be compulsory. Each question will be of 01 mark and there is no negative marking.
 - (b) Paper -II of this exam will contain 50 multiple choice questions and all questions will be compulsory. Each question will be of 01 marks and there is no negative marking.
 - (c) Candidates must ensure that the question booklets issued to them have all the questions. Defective question booklets can be changed within 10 minutes.
 - (d) Select and darken the circle corresponding to the answer on OMR sheet.
 - (e) In case more than one circle is darkened in a question, it will not be evaluated.
 - (f) Do not make any stray marks on OMR sheet and do not fold it.
 - (g) Any candidate found removing pages from the question booklet may be disqualified and prosecuted.

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- (h) Use of unfair means will disqualify the candidate from the examination.
- (i) No candidate will be allowed to leave the seat before handing over the original OMR sheets & question booklets to the invigilator. Candidate can take carbon copy of OMR sheet.
- (j) (i) First original OMR sheet & question booklet will be collected from the candidates from their seats by the invigilators at the end of Paper I, Paper II question booklet and new OMR sheet will be given immediately to the candidates.
